

## Cleaning Advice for „Steuler-Industrial Floors“

Floor coverings of all sorts are subject to a more or less strong soiling, depending on the stresses, and therefore have to be cleaned properly and at regular intervals to maintain the service performance.

The success of cleaning depends on :

- a) the sort of soiling
- b) the type of cleaning
- c) the cleaning method
- d) the used cleaning agents

### Point a):

For understandable reasons, a complete listing of all potential sorts of soilings is not possible within the scope of this Data Sheet. However, we have to point out that there are soilings which can be removed only under great difficulties and incompletely or even not at all, even with an intensive cleaning.

For example, rubber remains from tyres of forklifts can be removed only under great difficulties and often not completely without remains - fire patterns or completely polymerised resin spots cannot be removed at all.

### Point b):

The cleaning of our applications are limited to 3 types of cleaning:

1. Basic cleaning
2. Maintenance cleaning
3. Daily sanitising Maintenance cleaning in food areas.

### Point c):

Basically, cleaning methods are distinguished into manual cleaning – like sweeping and wet wiping – and machine cleaning with suitable cleaning devices.

### Point d):

The disinfection and cleaning agents mentioned in the Cleaning tables are the result of extensive tests. All products correspond to the proper instructions and requirements with regard to environmental and consumer protection.

The special properties of the cleaning agents are defined by the FBW-Classification.

Usually an optimal cleaning result can be obtained by observing the cleaning advice in the enclosed table.

We assume no liability for defects or damages to the floor coverings caused by incorrect cleaning methods, improper dosage or by using unsuitable cleaning agents.
